She is former Yeats Curator at the National Gallery of Ireland (2006 - 2008) and of the State Collection at Dublin Castle (1998 - 1999). She is co-editor and contributor to *Harry Clarke and Artistic Visions of the New Irish State*, (Irish Academic Press, 2018), *Censoring Art - Silencing the Artwork* (I.B.Tauris, 2018) and co-editor (with Fintan Cullen) of *Sources in Irish Art - A Reader*, (Cork University Press, 2021). Her monograph, *Art and the Nation State. The Reception of Modern Art in Ireland* was published by Liverpool University Press in 2021.

The lecture will be followed by a wine reception and the evening will end at 9.30 p.m.
