Visit to Kevin Barry Memorial Window in the Charles Institute of University College Dublin Wednesday 21st February 2024.

The Kevin Barry window, "one of the masterpieces of Irish art", is the work of Harry Clarke Studios and Richard King. Kevin Barry was an IRA volunteer executed during the War of Independence in 1920 by the British Army, aged 20, when he was a medical student in UCD. The window, commissioned by the medical students of UCD, was originally in Earlsfort Terrace, unveiled in 1934, and moved to UCD Belfield in 2010.
